Headington Market reopened on 4 July at Quarry Hollow Park

Headington Market is delighted to announce that it is reopening on 4 July at a temporary new location: Quarry Hollow Park. The market has moved from its home on London Road to Quarry Hollow Park to better provide shoppers and traders with a safer outdoor trading environment. Starting 4 July, the market will run each Saturday from 9am until 2pm and stall lists can be found on www.headingtonmarket.org and on Facebook.

The market will feature 10-12 stalls each week selling fresh, locally produced fruits and vegetables, meats, cheeses, fish, baked goods, as well as delicacies from around the world. Shoppers can find the park's entrance across from the Headington Quarry Village Hall on Quarry Road and plentiful cycle and car parking is located nearby. The park's exit is located, rather conveniently, around the corner from the popular Masons Arms Pub which is expected to reopen later in the summer.

The market's reopening has been highly anticipated by shoppers and traders alike although it is predicted that some customers will continue to use the online shopping and home delivery services that Headington Market traders have developed since the lockdown began. Online shopping continues to be available at www.headingtonmarket.org.

The Headington Market started in 2007 as part of the charity Headington Action and stall fees are used to support local community causes. In keeping with this charity mission, Headington Market traders have been delivering ready meals and other treats to the hard working staff at the Sobell House Hospice during June and will continue weekly deliveries until mid-July, as a thank you and also to raise awareness about the hospice's Emergency COVID-19 Appeal.

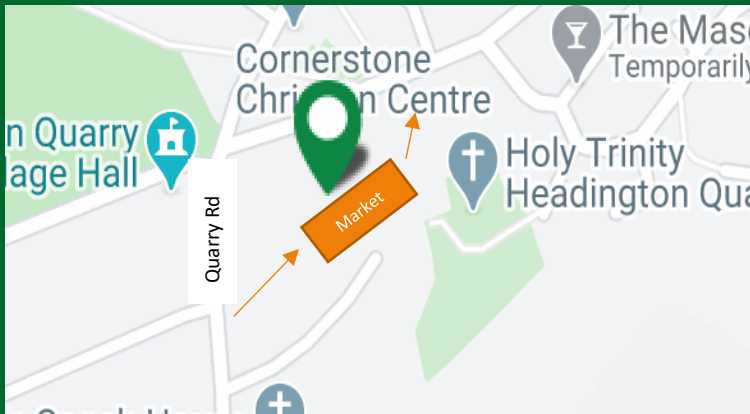

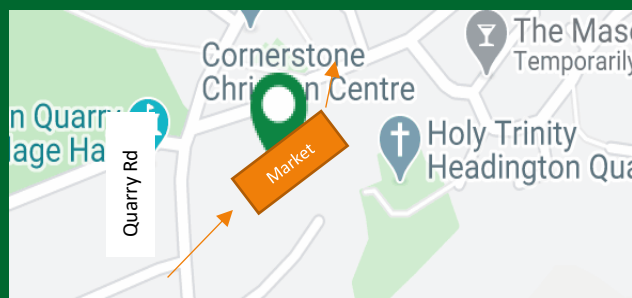
